

Specific Instructions for Uploading

Upload a PDF, JPEG, PNG file to submit the following:

- **Scholarly writing**, (academic essays, reports, etc.)
- **Creative writing**, (poetry, fiction, game narrative, screenplay, etc.)
- **Journalism** (editorial, review, interview, reporting, etc.)

PDFs are preferred and all writing samples must be in English. Please highlight a 300-word excerpt that you feel the committee must read because it is an important, creative, interesting part of the work. You may only skip the highlighting if your work is less than 500 words in total.

- **2D visuals** (drawing, graphics, painting, photography, etc.)
- **3D visuals** (sculpture, installation, augmented/virtual reality, 3D modelling, etc.)

Use a JPEG or PNG image file, a maximum of 2000 by 2000 pixels; it can be of any proportion within these bounds. To showcase 3D work, you should include images from different vantage points and compile them into one image (within the same 2000 x 2000 maximum). Indicate the dimensions of your work in centimeters. This is width by height for a 2D image, and width by height by depth for a 3D work. Do not include collections of visual work wherein the individual images do not connect to each other. The requirement is an object submission, not a portfolio—quantity does not indicate quality, and non-compliant submissions will not pass to the Admissions Committee for review.

Specific Instructions for Providing a URL

Provide URL to submit the following:

- **Time-based visual** (film, animation, VFX, motion graphics, etc.)
- **Audio** (podcast, sound design, etc.)
- **Interactive** (original games, data visualizations, interactive storytelling, immersive websites, etc.)

Provide a link to an external site to hold video, interactive, or audio works (e.g. WordPress, Vimeo, Soundcloud, YouTube, Google Drive, Twine, etc.) It is your responsibility to ensure that reviewers can access the work; sites that require a user to be logged in to view the work, monetized channels (with unskippable advertisements), and password-protected files will not be considered. YouTube videos should be uploaded as private videos to mitigate advertising. Spotify is not an accepted platform.

Tip: paste your link into an incognito or in-private browser window; if your content doesn't display immediately for you, it won't be evaluated by the Admissions Committee. If you created a game or interactive interface, and it is your original coding, please indicate the coding language or software you used to produce the work.
